- V. North Carroll Business Park update
 - a. Paige Sunderland gave a briefing on the status of construction work by White Pine.
 - b. Dave Bowersox updated that the land sale to Ridge has been recorded and he is waiting on payment.
 - c. Dave Bowersox reviewed terms of the new lease with Lippy's for the northern section of the NCBP. This lease is not automatically renewed as in the previous lease. If the IDA choses to lease for 2023 a new lease will need to be prepared.
- VI. Dulaney Property

Jack Lyburn addressed the Board. There is a text amendment being prepared to allow solar farms in the Employment Campus district. Once this is adopted the County will be subdividing the 20-acre parcel for a future solar farm. Mr. Lyburn recommends the IDA wait for this process to be completed before taking ownership of the remainder of the property.
