II. Presentation of engineering studies

Jason Azar reviewed his firm's work on the NCBP northern section and Dulaney property. He said the Employment Campus zoning presents an interesting development process. The idea of doing a market study on the property was discussed.

Mr. Bowersox described a commercial mixed-use zone development where frequently a property is co-developed by a residential developer and an industrial/commercial developer.

The NCBP northern property should have about 17.6 acres of usable flat ground. Construction prices today are about 50% higher than when the southern section of the NCBP was developed. Costs could be minimized by marketing to a single user which would save money on paving and storm drain, etc.

The Board asked Ms. Sunderland to get an updated appraisal on Dulaney and to check on property sales around the Westminster Technology Park to see if the \$250k per acre is still a fair market value.

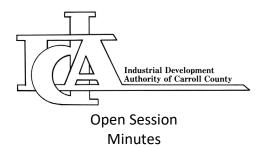
III. Approval of Minutes
